Dos

- □ Gather Supplies: Get all essential cleaning tools and products.

Focus on Key Areas:

Don'ts

- Don't Leave Personal Items: Ensure you've removed all belongings.
- Avoid Leaving Holes in Walls: Patch up any damage from decor or accidents.

- Avoid Using Harsh Chemicals on Delicate Surfaces: It can damage them.
